HER MAJESTY QUEEN SHIYIWE MANTFOMBI ZULU (1956 - 2021)

Indlovukazi Shiyiwe Mantfombi Zulu was born to the late Monarch of the Kingdom of e-Swatini, King Sobhuza and Princess Manoni Dlamini on 15 February 1956. She is the Sister of King Mswati III of eSwatini, Africa's only absolute monarch.

She was born at the Royal residence of Lugongolweni and being being born so close to what is known as a day of love all around the world, Valentines Day, she showed love, to all who came into contact with her, without regard to their rank or status! And she showed this love in practical ways! Since her passing, many have expressed that they will miss her love!

Although born eLugongolweni She was raised at Masundvwini, another Royal palace where she was raised by the mothers of the Royal household. They used to fondly describe her as a reserved and loving child who enjoyed being out in nature.


Her Royal Highness Queen Mantfombi or Mntanenkosi as she was known attended school at Lozitha High School .

It was at the age of 17 when the late King of Zulu Land King Goodwill Zwelithini ka Bhekuzulu spotted her at the Swazi Reed Dance, a ceremony where maidens of the land got together to celebrate their virtue.

The late monarch King Goodwill expressed his wishes to her brother Prince Masithela a senior Prince of Swaziland, to marry her, who then went on to express these wishes to King Sobhuza II, and a Royal match was arranged.

Queen Mantfombi, having been the daughter of a Reigning King in another Kingdom(a sovereign country, eSwatini), and 'owalotsholwa isizwe sama Zulu, is mourned supreme by isizwe sonke, the country, the African continent, and the International community at large! A marriage between the two Royals was also to strengthen relations between the Zulu and eSwatini Royal families.

Queen Mantfombi and King Goodwill Zwelithini got married in 1977! She made a home at the Royal Palace of KwaKhangelaMankangane where she had 8 children with the king, whom she had great love for.



Mntanenkosi was a great believer and a member of the 7th Day Adventist Church. She was known to be a highly spiritual person, and not just a church goer!

She was hailed for her involvement in the initiation and revival of many traditional ceremonies such as the Umkhosi Womhlanga which she revived in 1984; and the Marula festival which celebrates the harvesting of the Marula in the KwaNgwanase district. She was also instrumental in the Mkhosi Wokweshwama Festival which is the annual fruit harvest festival of the Zulu people.

Passionate about empowering others, the late Queen taught villagers various ways to be self –sufficient, including teaching them how to sew as well as grow their own vegetable gardens for subsistence. She will be missed by many because of such initiatives which empowered the Zulu nation!

On 20 March 2021, the late, His Majesty King Zwelithini appointed Queen Mantfombi to take charge of the Zulu nation as interim ruler, after his passing! She was interim ruler till she left us on 29 April 2021.

Therefore Queen Mantfombi (Indlovukazi) is survived by her children; Prince Misuzulu Zulu, Princess Ntandoyesizwe Zulu, Princess Nomkhosi Zulu, Princess Bukhosibemvelo Zulu, Prince Bambindlovu Makhosezwe Zulu, Prince Lungelo Zulu, Prince Mandlesizwe Zulu and Prince Simangaye Zulu; oNdlunkulu beSilo: Ka-Dlamini. Ka-Mathe, Ka-Ndlovu, Ka-Mchiza, and Ka-Mafu and their childen; Indlunkulu yonke Ka-Zulu; noZulu wonkana. They all mourn her deeply!
